



Exhibitor's Terms and Conditions

1. The owner, exhibitor, his/her agents, employees and assistants, whether formally employed or not and including any volunteers ('the Exhibitor'), by successfully applying to, and attending the Show, agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions of The Rotary Club of Lymington ('the Organiser'), and to comply with the reasonable requests of the marshals appointed by the Organiser.
 2. The Exhibitor must have valid third party insurance, any relevant MOT (if applicable) and other legally required certification for the vehicle or other item which they bring to the Show ('the Exhibit') and ensure that the Exhibitor and any other driver of the Exhibit has a valid and appropriate licence, and be qualified and competent to drive or handle the Exhibit. The Exhibit must be in safe working condition.
 3. The Exhibitor's property, including the Exhibit and any other vehicles and personal effects, will be allowed on the Show Site at the Exhibitor's own risk. The Exhibitor will indemnify the Organiser in respect of all risks, including but not limited to, fire, flooding, damage, theft of or accident to the Organiser's property, whatever the cause during the Show, during the setting up or dismantling of the Show or at any time the Exhibitor's Exhibit or other property is on site.
 4. The Exhibitor will be allowed on the Show Site at his/her own risk. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold The Organiser its members, agents and officials free from any claims that may be made by a person claiming that their loss or injury has been caused by the Exhibitor or persons under his/her direction or by his/her Exhibit or other vehicles or equipment of the Exhibitor, whatever the cause, during the Show, during the setting up or dismantling of the Show or at any time the Exhibitor's property is on site.
 5. The Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own Exhibit and other personal effects throughout the Show, during the setting up or dismantling of the Show or at any time the Exhibitor's property is on site.
 6. No Exhibit must be left unattended with its engine running. If, for any reason the Exhibit is left unattended, it **MUST** be left securely braked and immobilised with ignition keys removed. A maximum speed of 5MPH shall apply to all moving vehicles including the Exhibit on the Show Site.
 7. The Exhibitor must obey the instructions of marshals appointed by the Organiser and not inconvenience or endanger any persons or animals on the Show Site.
 8. All applications to attend the Show are accepted or rejected at the Organiser's sole discretion. Entry fees are non-refundable in the event of cancellation of the Show.
 9. Nothing in these terms and conditions is to be taken as relieving or excusing the Exhibitor from any legal duty or responsibility
